GENERAL HISTORY

The Dodge M37 3/4 ton truck was first built in 1951 as an upgrade to their WWII WC series trucks. Production began in January 1951 and lasted until 1968 with a total of 115,000 trucks. It was used extensively in the Korean War and through 1968 in the Viet Nam War when it was replaced by the M-715.

VEHICLE MARKINGS

This vehicle represents the 4th Fighter Interceptor Wing, 339th Fighter Interceptor Squadron. These pilots flew F-86 Sabres from ground bases in Japan and South Korea. This fighter wing was responsible for 516 air-to-air victories and boasted 25 Aces by the end of the Korean War.
