GENERAL HISTORY

The Willys M38A1 was produced from 1952-1971, with a production total of 101,488. Following the retirement of the flat fender M38, the M38A1 was redesigned with round front fenders, a contoured hood, two-piece windshield, top mounted windshield wipers, and outfitted with the 4-134 F engine and T90 transmission. The M38A1 (MD) was stronger than its civilian counterpart (CJ-5) with a stronger frame, suspension, reversed springs shackles and a 24 volt waterproof electrical system.

JEEP MARKINGS

This jeep is marked for the 2nd Infantry Division. In July of 1950 The 2nd was the first unit to reach Korea directly from the United States. Having fought for hilltops in the Iron Triangle, Pork Chop Hill, Baldy Hill, Bloody Ridge, and Heartbreak Ridge the 2nd Infantry Division emerged as the most decorated Division from the Korean War. 20 2nd Infantry Division Soldiers were awarded the Medal of Honor.
